Check-in

Check-in is after 3 pm.

Check-out

Please check out by 10:00 on your final day

Electricity

If you go out or check out, please make sure to turn off the air conditioner, room lights, etc.

Appliances

Please handle the appliances in your room with care so as not to break them.

If there is any damage, repair fees may be charged.

Please refrain from using the appliances incorrectly.

Kitchen

Feel free to use the cooking utensils, kitchenware, glassware, pots, and pans.

We ask you to clean the dishes and place everything back in its original location before you leave.

Toilet

Please keep the toilet clean during use.

Please don't flush gum, cigarettes and other foreign objects down the toilet. Because the toilet would be corrupted.

Bed
